# The Month of the Sacred Heart


June is the month of the Sacred Heart so I want to share with you some of the beautiful things Pope Francis has said about the Heart of Jesus:

"The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the greatest human expression of divine love. The Heart of Jesus is the ultimate symbol of God's mercy. Today let us not forget the love of God, the love of Jesus: he watches us, he loves us, he waits for us. He is all heart and all mercy. (Angelus, June 9, 2013)

"I would invite everyone to engage in what Benedict XVI called a formation of the heart. A merciful heart does not mean a weak heart. Anyone who wishes to be merciful must have a strong and steadfast heart, closed to the tempter but open to God. A heart which lets itself be pierced by the Spirit so as to bring love along the roads that lead to our brothers and sisters. Let us all ask the Lord: Fac cor nostrum secundum cor tuum: Make our hearts like yours (Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus). (2015 Message for Lent)

"We must have Jesus' heart who,'When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd' (Matthew 9:36). I like to dream of a Church that lives the compassion of Jesus. Compassion is to 'suffer with,' to feel what others feel, to share in their sentiments. A Church that has a heart without boundaries; but not just the heart, also the look, the gentleness of the look of Jesus, which often is more eloquent than many words. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is not just for a month but for every day. Through it we strive to live in union with the Heart of Jesus so that our hearts become more and more like his. That's my prayer for you, Apostle of Prayer, today and every day.
